

## High School Building Committee Meeting Minutes

### New Business

The meeting was a joint Building Committee and School Committee meeting to update the public on the building project progress and to seek input and feedback on the remaining options prior to making the selection of the preferred option. Mr. Adams opened the meeting by asking the school committee to introduce themselves, then Mr. Seymour did the same with the building committee. After brief opening statements from Mr. Seymour and new Superintendent Dr. Bartholomew, encouraging those in attendance to ask questions and share comments during the meeting, Jason Boone from Dore and Whittier began the presentation.

There were approximately 150 members of the public representing all 3 towns in attendance. At the conclusion of the meeting all were asked to submit an exit ticket asking for questions, comments and which of the options is the best solution. The presentation slides and video of the meeting was posted to the project page of the HS website along with an electronic version of the exit ticket. All the questions asked were reviewed by the working group and each was answered and then posted to the project website.
